

Approval to appoint of Physician(s) for the purpose of the NYS Education Law 913	WHEREAS, the Lewiston-Porter Board of Education is authorized under Section 913 of the NYS Education Law to require any person employed by the district to submit to such medical or health examinations as deemed necessary for the purpose of determining the physical or mental capacity of the employee to perform his or her duties; WHEREAS, the Lewiston-Porter Board of Education believes it is in the best interest of both the District and its employees for such referrals to be made without the need for individual Board approval; The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee is hereby authorized to require any employee to submit to a medical examination by a physician or other health care provider of his/her choice or the director of school health services of the board of education (otherwise known as the "school medical inspector"), as determined by the Superintendent, in order to determine the physical or mental capacity of the employee to perform his or her duties. The employee required to submit to such examination shall be entitled to be accompanied by a physician or other person of his or her choice. The determination based upon such examination as to the physical or mental capacity of the employee to perform his or her duties shall be promptly reported to the Superintendent or his or her designee. At any time, the Superintendent or his or her designee may direct any employee to be absent from his or her duties until the report of the determination based upon such examination is received. Dr. R.P Singh with offices located at 2000 Winton RD S, Rochester, NY 14618 be hereby appointed effective March 10, 2015 as an examiner of psychiatric services and to conduct such examinations as requested by the District pursuant to NYS Education Law Section 913. 
