Systems failure

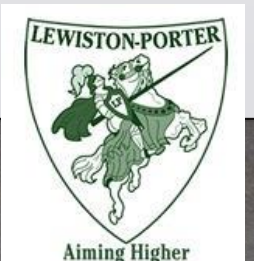

# Adoption of District Safety Plan

- Committee meets at least annually to review plan
- Approved annually
- 30 days public comment
- One public hearing prior to adoption
- District plan is public and will be posted on website

(Building plans are not public)



# Changes to the 21-22 District Safety Plan

- Administrator's names are updated
- Declared public health emergency–
  - identifying essential functions of the organization and those responsible
  - Safety plan including staggered shift/remote work, use of PPE, and cleaning procedures
